




**FACIAL IDENTIFICATION TRAINING (F.I.T.)** 

## **201 - Foundational 24-Hour Course**

This class will provide the participant with a system-agnostic introduction to Facial Examination and will address the following topics at a high-level: history of the discipline, agencies/organizations that are influencing the discipline, definitions, contributions to facial uniqueness, how to comparisons are completed (using ACE-V and Morphological Analysis methodologies), the stability of the facial features, and challenges in the discipline (to include image quality issues and bias).



Participants will have the opportunity to conduct comparisons using the knowledge learned along with documenting what is seen in the images. This class will also give the students an opportunity to complete some 1:N (one-to-many) comparisons if the program is compatible with the participants' computers. Can be offered in three, four, and five day sessions.

## **202 - Facial Examination** Course

## 5-or-10 Day Course

This course is aimed at improving the skill sets of the analyst and will provide the examiner with the necessary skills and strategies needed when conducting facial comparisons. Topics include history, bones and muscles, dermatology, aging, hair, the morphological features of the face, and comparison methodologies. Created for a small student to instructor ratio (12:1), the course provides extensive comparison exercises that apply what is learned during the lectures with feedback from the instructor as well as full class reviews of comparisons.
